At the end of January 1991, on the occasion of the baptism of Sandro and Maria Pia Marsala's son, Rodolfo Maria, celebrated by Mons. Dante Balboni in the Church of the Madonna of the Good Voyage (La Madonna del Buon Viaggio), with the presence of the Ambassador of Senegal in Italy, S.E. Youssouph Baro, was performed the departure toward San Pietro Island and Goree Island of the second little toy boat, transformed into a work of art, *Colombina*, by Silvio Betti as an art messanger for reconciliation and well-being in the living planet. On the Colombina's bottom there was the blueprint of the computer retina device made by George Chaikin and on one side of its sail the image of Piero della Francesca painting "*La Fragellazione*" and on the other side the 1986 *Purgatorio Show*'s image and a digital watch with main world clock times.



Colombina Reconciliation Project





Colombina, a symbolic toy boat, will connect all these places with S.Peter Island, Sardinia, to promote, with a network of cultural events, a new consciousness about our universal and interdependent patrimony. The Colombina Reconciliation Project, as a contribution to the Well Being Forum, will be a catalyst to generate the necessary collective energy to perform highly idealistic and poetical "well being" actions. I propose to have the United Nations as a point of reference for the promotion and diffusion of all the program in support of the quest for a "Well Being World" without discrimination of Art, Culture and Religions. On March 25, in Rome, at the International Institute of Epistemology "La Magna Grecia", it was established the Italian Committee of the 1992 CCC. It was made with the purpose to organize in 1992 in the Island of San Pietro the Well Being Columbus Reconciliation Forum, by prof. Saverio Avveduto, president of the International Institute of "la Magna Grecia" and cultural adviser of the Vice Prime Minister of Italy, as chairman of the Committee, prof. Francesco Aymerich, president of the Consortium CIFRA, as vice chairman, dean Carlo De Marco of the University of Rome "La Sapienza", S.E. Ambassador Youssouph Baro of the Republic of Senegal in Italy, proffs. Franco Meloni and Augusto Rinaldi of the University of Cagliari, prof. Renato Lazzari of the University of Rome "La Sapienza", Dr. Leopoldo Durante, representative of the City of Carloforte, dr. Nadia Guareschi, general secretary of the International Institute of "la Magna Grecia", in charge of external relations, and Sandro Dernini as general secretary of the Committee.

After several meetings in Rome of the Italian Artistic Telematic Committee, nothing happened and Plexus International moved his Telematic Team by itself.

In May, in Cagliari, Franco Meloni organized, at the Auditorium of the Sciences Building of the University of Cagliari, the presentation with the participation of Silvano Tagliagambe, Francesco

Aymerich, Sandro Dernini and Marco Mameli to promote the project to organize in the island of San Pietro in the October 1992 a telematic world wide symposium.

George Chaikin arrived from Ljubjana (Slovenia) at Sandro's house in Rome, on June 29, carrying a large colored blueprint of the electronic chip made from his Haddamard Matrix. Together with Giancarlo Schiaffini they performed the departure of the *Colombina Reconciliation Project* as a cultural navigation project to launch a fleet of coordinated creative projects for the 500 years of Columbus' landing in the Americas to be realized in the island of San Pietro as a world wide networking recalling reconciliation well being event, towards a change of route in the human use of the human being in the living planet.





As closing act, it was performed the departure of the fleet of project on board the little toy boat *Colombina*, carried into the sky by a colourful kite by Guido Pegna.

Leaving from Sardinia, the Italian Committee of the 1992 CCC expressed to Sandro Dernini its disagreement how Plexus happening with its fleet of art projects interfered with the institutional setting of the Forum presentation in Carloforte and it was requested in order to continue the collaboration as coordinator to not have any further Plexus International involvement in the organization of the 1992 Well Being Symposium

In the fall, Sandro Dernini, Franco Meloni, Fabrizio Bertuccioli, Piero Cianflone, and Stefano Asili, went to Carloforte to recover with Carlo Dernini and his crew the floating sculpture of Ciro Ciriacono which was creating navigation problems in the harbour. The sculpture was placed at the station of the astronomical observatory of the University of Cagliari in the island and *"Plexus Black Box"* instead was placed on board Elisabeth, with the Don Cherry's Buddha and other Plexus artworks carried from Rome with the *Plexus Black Bag*, a shopping tool by Micaela Serino.

It was managed under the creative direction of Gaetano Brundu, who curated its first exhibition "*Opening*", made as an installation created with the Plexus Black Box's relics and records.





At the end of November, the minister of culture of Senegal, Mustapha Ka wrote to Plexus International a letter in which it was stated his accord to the Plexus proposal to open in 1992, in Goree island, off Dakar, on the occasion of the arrival of the "Voyage of the Elisabeth", an International Art Fund as it was discussed in Rome with the Ambassador Youssouph Baro.
